1992 PORSCHE CARRERA CUP SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED

RENO, NEVADA, March 13, 1992 --- Porsche Cars North America, Inc., and the International Motor Sports Association (IMSA) today announced the schedule for the 1992 IMSA Porsche Carrera Cup race series.

The eight-race competition will begin Monday, May 25, at Connecticut's Lime Rock Park, and conclude Sunday, October 4, at Phoenix International Raceway in Arizona. Five of these 30-minute sprint events will run in conjunction with IMSA Camel GT races (Lime Rock, Mid-Ohio, Watkins Glen, Road America and Phoenix). The prestigious Canadian Grand Prix at Montreal will also host a Carrera Cup contest on Sunday, June 14, prior to the World Championship Formula 1 race. The remaining two Cup races will be held as companion events with the IMSA Exxon Supreme Series race at Road Atlanta and the Canadian Firehawk/World Challenge contest at Mosport Park near Toronto.

Each Carrera Cup race will feature a \$60,000 purse. Total prize fund for the series, including contingency money, is expected to exceed \$500,000. Every event will be nationally televised.

All vehicles competing in the 1992 IMSA Porsche Carrera Cup are identically constructed Porsche 911 Carreras, racing versions of the 1992 Porsche Carrera 2 production car, shod with Toyo F1-SR Z-speed-rated street radial tires with racing compound. To maintain equal competition throughout the season, all engines and transmissions will be sealed. Engine management systems will also be controlled. No unauthorized preparation in any of these areas will be permitted nor will substitution of any parts be allowed.
