Tough economic times have “indefinitely postponed” the **Porsche Carrera Cup’s** U.S. racing series, Porsche Cars North America announced last week. The company said **lack of a series sponsor** and a **small field** were responsible. Porsche said it fell short of the hoped-for 20 to 25 cars for the first race May 23 at Lime Rock.
